

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

THE UNIVERSITY OF GUADALAJARA

and

THE UNIVERSITY OF OLDENBURG

In order to extend the effective and mutually beneficial cooperation and the development of academic exchange in education, research and other scientific areas, the University of Oldenburg and the University of Guadalajara hereby agree to a cooperation towards the internationalization of higher education:

§1

The signing parties will cooperate in the areas of research and teaching, as well as in other scientific and academic areas. In particular, the following areas will be emphasized:

- exchange of faculty members, students and administrative and other professional personnel
- joint publications
- joint research projects.

The nature and extent of each cooperation project will be established in supplementary agreements between the contractual partners.

§2

The cooperation will be carried out by:

- The University of Oldenburg, School of Computing Science, Business Administration, Economics, and Law
- University of Guadalajara: Exact Sciences & Engineering, Economic and Administrative Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities

Both parties are to appoint a person to assume official responsibility for the maintenance and promotion of cooperation on a partnership basis:

§3

Upon signing by both contractual parties, this agreement of cooperation will be valid for a period of five years and will be renewed by the Parties during its validity, in accordance with the applicable regulations, and through the corresponding legal instruments. Amendments to the contract must be made in writing and with the mutual consent of the contractual partners.

§4

If this agreement is also signed in another language, both texts are of equal validity and effect. The agreement takes immediate effect after its approval and ratification by both partners upon the exchange of the signed documents.
