



SPECIFIC AGREEMENT FOR THE EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS BETWEEN

**YEUNGNAM UNIVERSITY
AND
UNIVERSIDAD DE GUADALAJARA**

The purpose of this document is to renew the Student Exchange program signed on 30 August 2013, in order to continue with the implementation of the Convention between Yeungnam University in the Republic of Korea and Universidad de Guadalajara in the United Mexican State.

The parties hereby agree that:

1. The purpose of this exchange program is to provide opportunities for the students of each institution to gain international experience by completing a pan of their education in the foreign host institution.
2. The academic extension programs of the Universidad de Guadalajara offered by its university enterprises, the Colegio de Español y Cultura Mexicana (CECM) and the Sistema Corporativo PROULEX- COMLEX are not included in this agreement.
3. Both institutions shall receive three (3) exchange students each for one full academic year. Each institution may send students for one semester rather than one full academic year. In this case, two students for one semester shall be equivalent to one student for one full academic year. While it may not be possible for both institutions to send 3 students each year, it is expected that over a three-year period, the number of imports and exports will be equal at each institution. If the balance is in one institution's favor, the parties agree to redress the imbalance within 90 days.
4. Each institution will inform the other institution about its plans for sending or accepting students before the agreed due date by it. The acceptance of students by each institution is guided by its own regulations and procedures.
5. The students will have the status of "Exchange Students" in the host institution and are considered belonging to their home institution. When they have attained good academic scores above the certain level on tests after attending classes, the host institution awards them credits. Upon request, a host professor as a supervisor will make a report of their academic performance for the home institution. The home institution will decide whether they will award any academic credit to them, on its own terms.
6. Both institutions shall waive the application, registration and tuition fees for the exchange students.
7. Both institutions shall assist the exchange students in satisfying visa requirements and appropriate immigration documents. Adequate health insurance is required for exchange students.



8. Both institutions shall provide assistance with identifying appropriate housing for exchange students.
9. Each students participating in the exchange program shall meet all the expenses, except the application, registration and tuition fees. Each student shall also meet the cost of health insurance at the host institution or country.
10. Further details of the specific conditions other than hereby described shall be worked out through ad hoc mutual consultation.
11. This agreement shall be valid from the date last signed below for a period of five (5) years and may be renewed thereafter upon written agreement of appropriate officials of both institutions.
12. This agreement is signed in two copies in Spanish language and two copies in the English language both versions with same content and validity
