



CO-OPERATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

**UNIVERSITY OF BASILICATA
(DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS, INFORMATICS AND ECONOMICS)
ITALY**

AND

**UNIVERSIDAD DE GUADALAJARA
(CENTER OF ECONOMICAL AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES)
MÉXICO**



The University of Basilicata, represented by the Rector, prof. Aurelia SOLE and Universidad de Guadalajara, Mexico, represented by the Rector Dr. Miguel Angel Navarro Navarro in order to establish and maintain scientific research and teaching relationships between the two Institutions, make preliminary arrangements for an exchange programme between teachers and researchers and integrate scientific research and teaching activities, agree as follows:

Art. 1

The University of Basilicata, Department of Mathematics, Informatics and Economics DiMIE, Italy, and the Universidad de Guadalajara, Center Of Economical And Management Sciences, hereinafter referred to as the Institutions, agree upon a co-operation on the following topics:

- 1. Join research projects;**
- 2. Entrepreneurship and innovation university development**
- 3. Join educational projects**
- 4. Exchange of students and academic staff**

The persons in charge of the programme will be:

From Università degli Studi della Basilicata: Prof. Giovanni Schiuma - DiMIE of the University of Basilicata

From Universidad de Guadalajara: Dr. Josè Sanchez Gutierrez - Jefe Departamento de Mercadotecnia y Negocios Internacionales of the Universidad de Guadalajara.

Art. 2

For such purpose, the Institutions agree to improve their co-operation as follows:

- by carrying out joint research projects,
- by exchanging academics, researchers, technical-administrative staff and other experts, students;
- by free admittance to the libraries and free access to the to research facilities existing in the participating Institutions;
- participation in conferences, symposia, congresses with scientific papers;
- by exchanging scientific information and materials on conditions agreed upon;
- by joint publications of the results obtained in joint projects;
- by any other kind of co-operation that may result useful to reach the joint objectives.

The programme could be increased and modified according to the common requirements and to the development of the undertaken research.



The Institutions agree that, in case of specific agreements and projects of collaboration deriving from this co-operation agreement, representatives of the two Institutions will be identified and sign such specific agreements that will be considered annexes of this co-operation agreement.

Art. 3

Within the limits of the regulations in force in each country, the parties agree to find the financial means necessary to reach the above mentioned objectives, also with the support of other institutions, government agencies and organisations operating at national and international level.

The expenses will be jointly identified and will be charged to the department/laboratory directly involved in the present agreement, unless specific funds from private or public institutions are available.

The parties agree to give the logistic support to the visitors.

Art. 4

All people concerned with the activities related to this agreement, shall submit an insurance and mobility costs scheme at their own original Institution which is in charge to take care of such costs.

To the academics, researchers and students that will benefit from this protocol will be ensured medical assistance, in the limits of the agreements concerning the reciprocal guarantees and assistance existing between the respective countries.

Art. 5

Unless otherwise agreed, the parties will jointly own the technological and scientific results obtained within the present co-operation programme. They undertake to protect and exploit them, according to the industrial laws and regulations in force in both Institutions. In order to allow an easier negotiability of the results, each party undertakes to prevent any claim of rights by its personnel or by persons in contact with the Institution.

Art. 6

This agreement shall be in force for 3 years maximum, from the date of the last signature by the legal representative of the contracting Institutions. Any amendment shall be made in written by the parties.

At the end of the third year period, this agreement will be automatically renewed according to the laws in force, unless a 6 months notice is issued by one Party to the other.

Art. 7

The present agreement consists of six equivalent texts, in English, Spanish and Italian.
