**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
THE BOSTON ARCHITECTURAL COLLEGE  
AND  
UNIVERSIDAD DE GUADALAJARA**

The Boston Architectural College (hereafter abbreviated as “BAC” or “the BAC”), located in Boston, Massachusetts, and Universidad de Guadalajara (hereafter abbreviated as “UdeG”) located at Guadalajara, Jalisco, México, agree to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), for the purposes of encouraging and strengthening academic partnerships; enhancement and amplification of educational programs for mutual benefit; and fostering cooperation between both institutions, particularly in design disciplines.

**Programs and Exchanges**

The BAC and UdeG, based upon the principles of respect for each other’s independence and of mutual benefit, may participate in the following activities:

- a) Exchange of students
- b) Exchange of faculty, administrative staff members, and scholars
- c) Exchange of materials, publications, and information
- d) Joint organization of seminars, workshops, studios, and conferences
- e) Development and delivery of cooperative or joint educational programs and projects
- f) Development of Credit Transfer and Articulation Agreements

This Memorandum authorizes the Administrations and Faculties of the BAC and UdeG to engage in discussions and negotiations leading to detailed cooperative programs and/or projects. Such programs and/or projects will be subject to review and approval of both the BAC and UdeG.

The BAC and UdeG agree that the proposed programs, projects or work agreements that arise from this MOU, will be elevated to the category of specific agreements of collaboration and will be considered annexes to this MOU, once signed by their representatives.

## Review


1. This MOU is subject to review 3 years from the date of Agreement, and may be valid for 3 years, and will cease when the parties agree, or within three months of the issue by either party of a written request to terminate.
2. This Agreement may be revised or terminated upon mutual consultation and consent between both institutions.
3. In the event of amendment or termination, both institutions will honor to completion any commitments already in progress at the time of amendment or termination. Commitments agreed upon prior to, but not yet in progress at the time of, amendment or termination may be honored to completion if mutually agreed upon by both institutions.
4. This Agreement will be effective when signed by all representatives indicated in the signature fields below.
5. This Agreement does not confer automatic or unapproved use of the BAC brand, logo, or name. All uses of the BAC brand, logo, or name must be approved in accordance with institutional standards and principles, as set forth by the pertinent governing Department(s).
6. This Agreement does not confer automatic or unapproved use of the UdeG brand, logo, or name. All uses of the UdeG brand, logo, or name must be approved in accordance with institutional standards and principles, as set forth by the pertinent governing Department(s).


