




MEMORANDUM OF THE AGREEMENT  
on  
UMAP MULTILATERAL STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM  
between  
UNIVERSITY OF GUADALAJARA  
AND UMAP INTERNATIONAL SECRETARIAT

University of Guadalajara, México, and UMAP International Secretariat as the representative of UMAP Organization hereby agree to determine the details for implementation of an exchange of undergraduate and graduate students (hereinafter referred to as exchange students).

1. The selection of exchange students will be subject to the academic regulations of each host university. The participating universities agree to number of exchange students per academic year in each university will not in principle exceed two (2).
2. Exchange students shall be permitted to stay at the host university not longer than one year.
3. Exchange students will not be subject to fees for examination, admission and tuition from the host university.
4. Exchange students will be given an official letter of participation by the host university to apply for visas for a length of time equivalent to the exchange term in the country where the host university is located.
5. At University of Guadalajara, undergraduate students will be accepted with the status of Visiting Foreign Students or Non-degree Foreign Students, and graduate students with the status of Visiting Foreign Students, Special Research Students, or Foreign Research Students, based on the short-term student exchange program.
6. Exchange students may enroll in any courses (classes) offered by each university, except specific courses determined by the host university.
7. All participating universities agree to endeavor to transfer credits earned by exchange students at the host university, subject to the regulations and procedures of the respective universities. For credit conversion and transfer among participating universities, all institutions shall use the UCTS (UMAP Credit Transfer Scheme) of UMAP (University Mobility in Asia and the Pacific).
8. All participating universities shall endeavor to provide accommodation or help exchange students to find appropriate accommodation.
9. Concerning the implementation of the above program, open and widespread participation shall be encouraged, particulars shall be discussed and agreed upon by all participating universities whenever necessary.
10. Termination of the memorandum requires notification at least one year prior to termination.
11. The memorandum shall be concluded in English. Any revision or modification of the agreement shall be made in writing through mutual discussion and negotiation.
