1. VISA

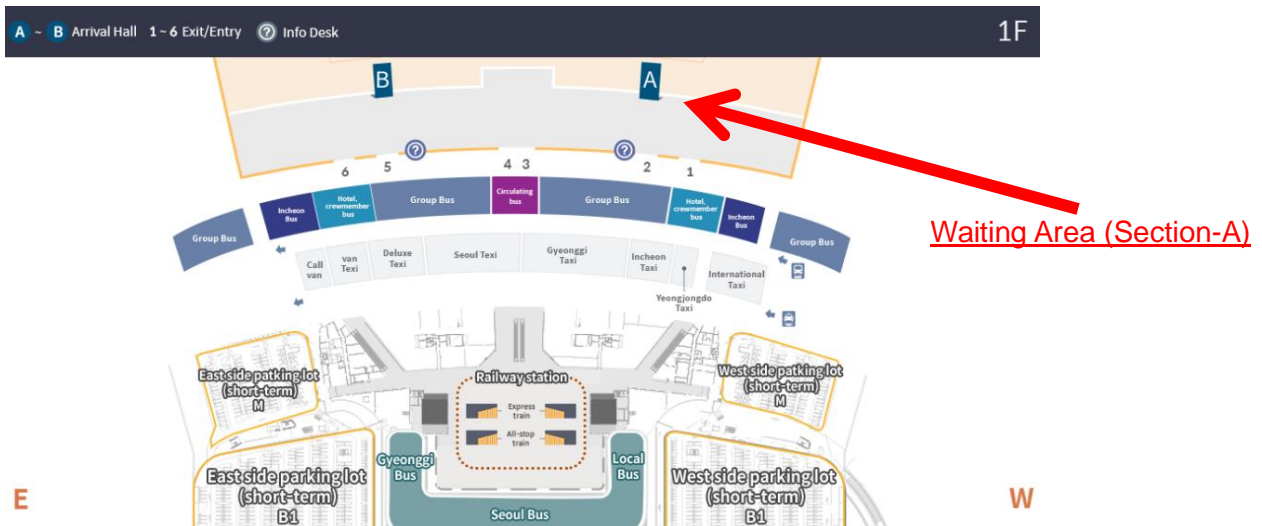
After obtaining a passport, you should directly apply for the D-2-8 visa at the appropriate consular section of the Korean embassy in your home country. Along with the required documents which should be authenticated by contacting the aforementioned consular section, please bring your KDU Admission Certificate along with KDU Scholarship letters issued by us. We will send you the original admission and letters by post. For your information, tourist or on-arrival visas are NOT acceptable for our program.

2. ARRIVAL (AIRPORT PICK-UP) AND DEPARTURE (AIRPORT DROP-OFF) SCHEDULE

- Airport: Incheon International Airport (Incheon Airport has two terminals)
- TERMINAL-1: Your arrival will be to the Arrival Floor (1F), please come to the waiting area in **Section-F**.



- TERMINAL-2: Your arrival will be to the Arrival Floor (1F), please come to the waiting area in **Section-A**.

- You will be guided to Kyungdong University, Goseong-gun by our staff at the airport. Transportation fee will be covered at our expense.

4. FLIGHT DETAILS

- Please **open the attached excel file** and check the information written and fill other blanks and send it back along with a copy of your ticket to Prof Absi at enquiries@kduniv.ac.kr
- We advise you to check your email periodically until you enter Korea so you don't miss any important information. If your entry schedule changes due to an urgent matter, you should immediately contact us at enquiries@kduniv.ac.kr.

5. FROM AIRPORT TO KYUNG DONG UNIVERSITY, STUDENTS IN KOREA

- We will pick up all students from airport within the recommended arrival dates. However, students who might come afterwards might have to get the limousine buss from Incheon airport to Sokcho. The ticket office is next to the exit 9 located at 1st Floor of arrival Terminal 1. if you arrived at terminal 2, you can get on the bus at the bus stop 9. You can ask for more information at the airport information desk, where consultation services are provided in various languages. You should get off at the final bus terminal (Sokcho Bus Terminal). Ticket cost: 31,000KRW, Time required: approximately 4 hours, Sokcho Bus Terminal To KDU (by taxi): Approx. 8min. After you get to Sokcho Bus Terminal, take a taxi and arrive at Kyungdong University. Show a taxi driver the sentence below:

“경동대학교 기숙사 송레원으로 가주세요”

(I would like to go to the dormitory of Kyungdong University.)

- If you are currently staying in Korea, please come to Kyungdong University Global, Goseong-gun between June 24 to 26 and let me know your arrival date and time.

6. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Students attending Session-3, please bring your university enrollment letter, copy of your current academic transcripts, and Language proficiency (if any, TOPIK, IELTS, iBT). No documents required for Session-1 & 2.

7. BUDDY PROGRAM

- International students might match with Korean students in buddy program. This program is meant to help international students adjust to new Korean life and to study Korean language and culture.
- Your assigned buddy might make a contact via email one week before your arrival. Please keep contact with your buddy and ask if you need any help regarding to Korean life. Of course, you still can contact me for any inquiries you might have.
- You might spend time with your buddy from your arrival date to end of your session.

8. KDU ORIENTATION AND MATRICULATION CEREMONY

- KDU Orientation:
 - All students will have an arrival orientation upon their arrival to KDU campus and will receive an arrival kit.
- KDU Matriculation Ceremony:
 - All students have to participate in the Matriculation Ceremony on July 1 to conclude their registration formalities as bona fide students of the university.

9. THINGS TO PREPARE

- Upon your arrival to KDU, we will help you to register your details at the Sokcho Immigration Office for your Alien Registration Card (ARC). The processing fee is around \$100 (\$80 for ARC + \$20 for Medical checkup).
- There will be a Cultural Program on July 26, students interested in showing their culture or talents might bring their traditional clothes and any other materials or instruments.
- The standard voltage in Korea is 220 volts at 60 Hertz, and the outlet has two round holes so please bring appropriate adaptors.

Q & A

- Dormitory
 - Free dormitory.
 - Two persons/ room. Different floors between males and females. Our dormitory masters supervise 24 hours. Safety will be assured!
 - Meals are not included. The dormitory cafeteria will be open during working days-Monday to Friday so you can buy your meals. Otherwise, there are plenty of restaurants located around the campus.
 - The dormitory is located on the campus. It takes 2 minutes to walk from the dormitory to the buildings where your Korean classes are held.

- You will know your room number and roommate at your arrival. All rooms offer free Wi-fi service.
 - Common Facilities: lounge, study room, gym, coin washing machine.
 - If you have any specific dietary requirements, please inform us prior to arrival.
- *Korean Language & Culture program*
- The classes will be more than one level from very beginner to the advanced.
 - Korean language classes: Every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 9 am - 1 pm.
 - Cultural activities: Every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday afternoon (adjustable) from 1 pm - 5 pm. Long field trips will be every Wednesday and Friday from 6 am – 7 pm.
 - Please check the attached files for program details of all sessions.
- *Leave out of Korea in the middle of the summer program*
- It is strictly prohibited to take a trip out of Korea in the middle of your summer program session. For some cases, you have to ask approval for your leave in advance from Dean of International at KDU.
