2019 KDU GLOBAL FULLY-FUNDED INTERNATIONAL SUMMER PROGRAM, SOUTH KOREA

The program will be conducted in English-medium and FULLY FUNDED by Kyungdong University which covers Fee, Dormitory, Airport pick up and drop off, Local Transportation, and other Organizational Expenses. Airfare and other living expenses are to be borne by the participants. Students can choose to cook themselves using dormitory cooking facility or buy food at school restaurant. There is no limit on the number of students from any university. We are expecting to host more than 200 international students with 100 Korean students from selected higher educational institutions worldwide.

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must hold IELTS 6 at least or be an English speaker or any other adequate proof of their English proficiency.

Students should obtain short-term student visa (D-2-8) from the nearest South Korean embassy prior to their travel.
